

#### **Māori solutions**

Deliberately breaking tapu: Miscarriage was punishment from the gods

- Eating food prepared for tohunga
- Eating food in sacred (tapu) place
- Passing cooked food over tohunga garment or resting place



#### **British law in 1800s**



1803 Offences Against the Person Act illegal 'to procure the miscarriage of any women then being quick with child' incurred the death penalty, regardless of whether the child was born alive or dead

1837 Illegal whether or not quickening had occurred



1861 Woman herself liable if she attempted to procure her own abortion - maximum penalty life imprisonment


1889 NZ Offences Against the Person Act replicated British statute



## 1961 Amendment to NZ Crimes Act

Abortion < 20 weeks gestation lawful if 'person doing the act believed that continuance of pregnancy would result in serious danger... to life, or physical or mental health, of woman or girl'

'Termination committees' - senior gynaecologists plus co-opted others such as psychiatrists







- Women needed referral from GP, see 2 certifying consultants then surgeon
- Socio-economic hardship, rape, incest, health of mother, carrying grossly abnormal baby born with serious handicaps, not grounds





#### **Abortion Legislation Act 2020**

Public Act 2020 No 6 Date of assent 23 March 2020



#### Abortion is healthcare issue

- No longer under Crimes Act
- Women can freely request abortions (up to 20 weeks gestation) – no statutory test
- Any registered healthcare practitioner, within their required scope & skill set, can provide medical abortions, rather the process reliant on doctors
- No requirement for licenced premises
